## 68/19 REPORT FROM COUNTY COUNCILLOR RICHARD HOSKING, INCLUDING OUTSTANDING ITEMS FROM PAST MEETINGS:

No report received from Cllr Hosking, the outstanding items list below to be reviewed at November's Parish Council meeting.

51/19 Flooding from highways water run-off at "The First and Last Bistro" car park.

51/19 Trial scheme to restrict the width of the road near "The First and Last Bistro" to see if it would slow down traffic. Ideas being progressed. Clerk to e-mail Nick Colton and ask why this work cannot be pursued in the next financial year. ACTION: Clerk

51/19 Blocked drains on the left-hand side of Town Hill and Chapel Street. Grate to be removed to assess the situation. Ongoing

51/19 River Erme erosion A3121 - aerial survey is due this year. When completed an assessment of movement of riverbank will be confirmed. **Ongoing** 

51/19 Playing field application to be a Village Green.

## 69/19 REPORT FROM DISTRICT COUNCILLOR TOM HOLWAY, INCLUDING OUTSTANDING ITEMS FROM PAST MEETINGS:

Cllr Holway reported on South Hams District Council Climate Change Working Group, which is still being worked on and will be promoted via the Council's website.

52/19 Reinstatement of path around the playing field owned by SHDC by the river. Still being pursued.

52/19 Industrial Units – light pollution, may be practical to install alternative lighting. PSI has not been done and the lights are remaining switched on. **Still being pursued.** 

52/19 The flue on "The Crooked Spire" - masonry chimney to be placed around the flue after Heritage Officer has agreed the design. SHDC awaiting drawings from the property owner.

## 70/19 QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS FROM MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO THE PARISH COUNCIL, COUNTY & DISTRICT COUNCILLORS AND POLICE (A PERIOD OF NOT MORE THAN 15 MINUTES)

Parishioner asked for the Parish Council to be more forceful with DCC on the addressing the speed of traffic through the village, as it is treacherous for pedestrians. There are plans to have a Community Shop adjacent to the road, behind "The First and Last", which will generate more pedestrians on the road. The parishioner is prepared to take speed readings of vehicles along the road if provided with a speed gun.

A parishioner involved with a project to restore the bell frame of the church, would like support from the Parish Council. To be placed on the agenda for discussion at November 2019 meeting. **ACTION: Clerk**

## 74/19 HONEY'S FIELD

The Parish Council were not successful with purchasing the land, but wish to work with the new owner.

## 74/19 PUBLIC OPEN SPACE (POS)

No update.

Standing Orders were suspended.

Cllr Cross asked a parishioner to give an indication of what "The Spires" residents might wish for the Public Open Space. Parishioner said he could not speak for all, but felt that the majority did not wish for a 'manicured' site but would welcome some tidying of the area. They also suggested that BDW saw no reason to create a 'manicured' space.

Standing Order were reinstated.

## 75/19 CLIMATE CRISIS - Cllr Cross & Parish Tree Warden

Cllr Cross has been liaising with SHDC, who are happy for trees to be planted in the playing field. Has also been liaising with the Parish Tree Warden.

Standing Orders were suspended.

The Parish Tree Warden circulated a plan showing where the whips (slender, unbranched young tree seedlings, 2–3 years old) will be planted. The scheme has been devised to move the whips away from the middle of the field.

Standing Orders were reinstated.

Cllr Martin asked that the whips not be planted where it is proposed to build the village hall. The Parish Tree Warden pointed out that due to the size of the whips, they could be moved within two years of being planted.

Cllr Allis asked for Parish Councillors' views on the proposal and it was agreed to persue the idea. Cllr Cross will liaise with Rob Sekula, Specialist – Assets & Place Making, South Hams District Council. **ACTION: Cllr Cross**
