### **Appendix II – Correspondence since 8 July 2014**

10 July 2014 – correspondence from a parishioner living in Ponquit regarding the antisocial behaviour and damage to his property from car drivers – **information to be circulated at the meeting.**

10 July 2014 - Parishioners request for access at the corner where The Spires meets "Talata". This would enable safer access to the pathway to the playing field rather than walking along the road to the main entrance to The Spires. **ACTION: recommendation to be discussed.**

31 July 2014 – letter and photographs regarding an incident involving a parishioner at Ludbrook Cross. Letter contains recommendations on how to make the "T" Junction safer. Cllr L Ward was also sent the information and has been liaising with County Cllr R Hosking. **ACTION: letter to be circulated and recommendations to be discussed.**

e-mail from Devon County Council – 08/08/2014 = information on the new consultation in relation to the Devon Waste Plan which will cover the period to 2031 – *e-mailed to Councillors.*

e-mail from S.H.D.C. – 14/08/2014 = Issue 3 of Our Plan Latest News. The edition looks at what land might be available for development and how sites are being considered for potential development in the future. The information does not make any decision about where development will or will not go – *e-mailed to Councillors.*
