075/2020 REPORT FROM DEVON COUNTY COUNCILLOR RICHARD HOSKING, INCLUDING OUTSTANDING ITEMS FROM PAST MEETINGS

1. The incidence of Coronavirus has sharply increased in Devon with 539 cases confirmed in the week to 4th October. This brings the total confirmed cases in the County to 2,241. Over four hundred of the new cases this week are in Exeter and the majority associated with the University. We are fortunate that this is still a relatively low level of infection.

2. Eleven schools in Devon have been obliged to isolate at least one teaching pod including lvybridge and Ugborough.

3. We await the publication of the Local Outbreak Management matrix and I anticipate this may be produced for the Team Local Outbreak Engagement Board meeting on Thursday 8th October.

4. Remember, Hands, Face, Space and the rule of 6.

5. We have now entered October and a reminder that it is time to check the Grit Bins. We are asking Parish Councils to report those that are low on grit on the Report-a-Problem webpage as soon as convenient please.

6. My enquiry of the Devon County Council solicitor advised that the report on the Ermington Village Green appeal is expected shortly.

"I am hoping to make arrangements later this week for the application to be passed to the County Solicitor who has delegated powers to make the decisions for applications submitted to Devon County Council under the Commons Act 2006."

7. I have received correspondence from Andy Booth concerning flooding issues at Flete Eastern Lodge. I am in the process of establishing the history and current position with regard to this issue.

8. Correspondence has been received from Barbara Jones concerning the hedge growth adjacent to the A3121 at Ermington. One metre growth over the highway and DCC Nick Colton is assessing the situation.

9. The remainder of the gulley pots on the road from Strode Cross to Crownhill have now been cleaned.

10. Enquiries have been made with regard to additional traffic calming measures around the school access routes in the village, include a request to Councillor Stuart Hughes for a "dragon" (once this has been trialled). Conversations with Highways did not leave much room for optimism as the existing 20 mph speed limit was quite recently formally approved indicating that existing traffic calming works are adequate.

Cllr Cross asked what were SHDC views on "Planning for the Future" white paper? Cllr Holway replied stating that SHDC are not in support of the proposals. Clerk was asked to write to SHDC development and legal department and ask for a copy of the SHDC response to the paper. **ACTION: Clerk**

Cllr Onley – Flete Eastern Lodge owner has pointed out there is flooding issues in the area near his home. Cllr Hosking stated that there are suggestions that he is looking into.

Cllr Onley – enquired if 20 mph signs could be placed on highway posts within the village, if the parish council purchased them. Cllr Hosking suggested that Nick Colton – DCC Highways is contacted.

Cllr Onley – pointed out highway signs within the parish are not visible in many locations due to vegetation. Cllr Hosking stated DCC Highways are accessing the situation.

Cllr Cross – Ermington Primary school have staggered times for entering and picking children. If a volunteer could be found, could equipment be provided for a Lollypop person. Cllr Hosking will investigate. **ACTION: Cllr Hosking**
