£19,440 (reduction of 20%) Band D property will show £51.14 for the Ermington element of the total bill. This is a decrease of -19.7% or -£12.51 on the 2020/21 Band D figure.

017/2021 FUNDS RAISED FOR THE READING ROOMS PROJECT – Clir C Cross

Cllr Cross gave the background to the raising of funds for the purchase of Honey's Field.

The Ermington Village fund has asked for their fund raising money of £3,500 paid to the Parish Council in June 2012, for the purchase of Honey's Field, to be paid back.

Cllr Onley pointed out that as so much time has passed and none of the current Parish Cllr's were involved at the time, any decision would need to be informed by the published accounts and minutes. These show that the Parish Council between 2012 and 2016 spent over £8000 on proposals to buy Honey's Field and extend the Reading Rooms, including £3300 on legal fees and £3750 on architect's fees before abandoning the project in favour of a new build Village Hall on the playing field.

Any request to return monies donated for the purchase of Honey's Field could have been considered at that time, but the Council decided instead to transfer any surplus funds to the new build project.

With the opening of the Hub there are now no plans to build a new Village Hall and the current Council policy is to return any surplus reserves to parishioners by lowering the Parish Precept.

The Parish Council has been very generous in financial support to the Village Fund over many years, and also provided information and links to SHDC and DCC grants which can be viewed on the parish website.

Discussion ensued, it was resolved not to return any money donated towards these projects as considerable costs were incurred and to continue to return surplus reserves direct to parishioners by the Parish Precept.

- e) Footpath from Higher Keaton to Fernham enquiries from parishioners, why the footpath is not on OS maps = **CIIr Yates** information to be sent to CIIr Owens to pursue.
