042/2021 PUBLIC OPEN FORUM - Questions and Comments from Members of the Public to Parish

Councillors, County and District Councillors

Parishioner – reported an Ash sampling is growing on the bridge by the turning to Strode on the A3121. See photo below:



Also a wall that supports the road near Newmills, Ermington, has collapsed and fallen into the river on the lower side of the weir/waterfall. See photo below:



Parishioner - on land opposite the scrap yard near Tod Moor, Westlake, mature trees are being felled, is this allowed? It was RESOLVED Cllr Holway will check who owns the land and if there has been any planning permission. **ACTION: Cllr Holway**

Parishioner - road to Upton Farm is in a very bad condition. It was RESOLVED that Cllr Thomas will look at the road with Nick Colton DCC Highways. **ACTION: Cllr Thomas**

Parishioner – enquired who cut the trees and left the debris near Upton Farm. It was RESOLVED that Cllr Holway will liaise with the landowner. **ACTION: Cllr Holway**

Parishioner – when pedestrians are exiting the footpath and stepping onto the highway (A3121) near Plantation House, it is very dangerous. Could the hedge be trimmed back to improve visibility? It was RESOLVED that Cllr Owens will contact Parish Paths Coordinator at Devon County Council. **ACTION: Cllr Owens**

Parishioner pointed out that speeding has increased on the A3121 since the roundabout near Hollowcombe has been opened. Cllr Creese confirmed a speed sign will be placed on the road.

Volunteers are needed for Community Speed Watch which is an educational scheme to help people reduce speeding traffic though their community. The scheme enables volunteers to work within their community to raise awareness of the dangers of speeding and to help control the problem locally. 043/2021 REPORT FROM DEVON COUNTY COUNCILLOR DAN THOMAS, INCLUDING OUTSTANDING ITEMS FROM PAST MEETINGS

Correspondence had been received from a parishioner, concerning the hedge growth adjacent to the A3121 near Erme Bridge Cottages, Ermington, which has been raised with Nick Colton, DCC Highways. Cllr Thomas was assured by Nick Colton that the hedges in question are assessed monthly by an inspection gang. If growth impedes the highway, letters are sent to landowners. Unless vehicles are pushed over the centre white line of the highway as a result of growth, it is not deemed overgrown. Cllr Thomas asked to be informed if the situation is causing an issue.

Following correspondence with former Cllr Claire Cross and conversations with Nick Colton, DCC Highways, it has been agreed that the 20mph road markings are going to be repainted and an assessment made of the general road markings around Ermington Primary School. The dragon traffic calming mural idea in Exeter has yet to be accepted as Devon County Council policy. **ACTION: Cllr Thomas**
