Speeders

Not seeing signs and only slowing at flashing detector.

Margaret's Drive / E-RHEWOOD

Few speeders at 40mph limit.

Be interested to see what happens at 30mph new limit. New site permissions in process for new site on grass outside Plantation House. A 2 in 1 site as traffic can be monitored both ways at separate times.

SHDC car park.

Coming out of the village. Very few speeders

Speed bumps slow down

Max speed between bumps less than 21mph

War memorial

Some speeding after speed bump downhill towards junction. Difficult to record.

Skateboard Park

Minimal speeding at current 40 mph. Will become interesting if/when limit reduced to 30mph

Mill Hill (in between speed bumps)

Only idiots would speed coming up dip to first speedbump out of village, but some do! (4 out of 97).

Not easy to record vehicles coming up dip past 'First and Last' – usually recorded at the last minute.
